THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

In today's Gospel, we hear about the preparations the disciples made for the Passover, just before the death of Jesus. They ask Jesus what they are to do. He tells them to go into the city and prepare a room for the meal. And in the second part of the text, we hear the words of Jesus that mean so much. "This is My Body," and, "This is My Blood." In the Gospel of Mark, which we hear today, He continues, "the blood of the covenant." The US Bishop's explain, "His blood of the covenant both alludes to the ancient rite of Exodus 24:4-8 and indicates the new community that the sacrifice of Jesus will bring into being." A covenant is more than a contract. It is a deep and binding promise, a bond. On this Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, our attention is especially drawn to the Eucharist. How do we understand the Eucharist? What does it mean to us? Does being nourished by the Eucharist translate into a different way of life? Today we are given an opportunity to reflect on these questions. It is important to think about how our belief translates into our daily life - as Pope Benedict says, "so that Christ may walk where we walk and live where we live."
