GOLDEN JUBILEE OF THE BAMENDA – PORTSMOUTH LINK

This year is the 50th anniversary of the formation of the link between the Archdiocese of Bamenda and the Diocese of Portsmouth, which will be marked with celebrations at our Cathedral in Portsmouth on Saturday 6th July and in Bamenda in November. Archbishop Andrew Nkea and Fr Bernardine Nsom will be leading a delegation of 13 priests, religious and laity from Bamenda, visas permitting, in early July. They are planning to visit some of our twinned schools and the parishes where five of their priests from Bamenda are now serving us in the diocese, as well as joining Bishop Philip for a Mass of Thanksgiving at St John's Cathedral on Saturday 6th July at 11am. Please join us at the Cathedral for what promises to be a joyous Celebration Mass, followed by an exhibition and displays in the Discovery Centre in the afternoon, ending with Evening Prayer and Blessing at 4pm. We are expecting to be joined by some 100 members of the Cameroonian Community from around the UK! Please come for all or any part of the day.
